Options open <u>December 1st, 2021</u> for renewing or obtaining a Private Pesticide Applicator License.

A **Private** Pesticide Applicator License is required if you are **applying** *any* type of pesticide (*herbicide, insecticide, fungicide, rodenticide, etc.*) on agriculture land that you own/lease/rent that has the potential of producing more than \$1,000 of an agricultural commodity.

A **Private** Pesticide Applicator License is required *anytime* a Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP) is **purchased** or **applied**.
