Non-commercial Thinning Programs Available to Private Landowners in the Black Hills of South Dakota

<u>Environmental Quality Incentive Program and Conservation Stewardship Program</u> – These are USDA Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) financial assistance programs to assist producers that complete conservation practices to manage their private forestlands.



Cost Share: Flat rate payment per acre

Requirements: (1) applies to private forestland (2) must be located within a CIS priority area (3) must follow written prescription and (4) all slash must be treated to meet the SD Logging Slash Abandonment treatment standards.

Where do I apply? Apply with the District Conservationist at your local NRCS office in the USDA Service Center. USDA Service Centers are located in Belle Fourche, Rapid City, Hot Springs, and Sturgis.

When can I apply? Anytime – Call ahead to schedule an appointment How Do I Apply? Visit your local USDA Service Center

<u>Conservation Commission Grant Programs</u> – These programs apply to private forestland owners within Lawrence, Pennington, Custer, and Fall River Counties through the Conservation Districts. The funds and technical assistance are available to assist the completion of forest management practices.



<u>Cost Share</u>: 50% of treatment cost up to a maximum of \$325/ac (half of \$650/ac total project cost)

Requirements: (1) applies to private forestland (2) must follow written prescription and (3) all slash must be treated to meet the SD Logging Slash Abandonment treatment standards.

Where Do I apply? Local Conservation District office When Can I apply? Anytime – Call ahead to set up an appointment How do I apply? Pick up an application from the Conservation District office.

<u>Fire Hazard & Fuels Reduction Program</u> — This program provides cost-share funds to private landowners to reduce the threat of catastrophic fire by removing hazardous fuels. This is achieved through the creation of fuel breaks and removing ladder fuels and down woody debris from the forest floor.



<u>Cost Share</u>: 50% of Fuels treatment up to a max of \$800/ac (half of \$1,600 total cost) for 6.5 ac around structures/homes

Requirements: Qualification of a property will be at the discretion of the Division of Wildland Fire staff.
