Common Burdock

(Arctium minus)











Roots: taproot, large, fleshy

Stems: erect, much-branched, somewhat grooved or angular, usually reddish

Leaves: alternate, blades simple, margins wavy or shallowly lobed

Flowers: rose or purple to pink or violet disk florets

Origin: Eurasia
