## White Horehound

(*Marrubium vulgare*)



**Roots:** taproot, branched, woody, with numerous fibrous lateral roots

**Stems:** dense, white woolly 4-angled stems branching from a somewhat woody base

**Leaves:** opposite, round to oval in outline, corrugated (wrinkled), pale green above and white woolly beneath, with coarsely-toothed margins

**Flowers:** small white tubular

**Origin:** Europe
