INTERVENOR, Bruce Ellison, pursuant to SDCL §1-26-18 and SDCL §1-26-19, hereby moves the Hearing Chairman of the Board of Minerals and Environment to authorize the issuance of a subpoena to Commissioner Bock Greenfield, Commissioner, SD Office of School & Public Lands to compel his testimony at the Evidentiary Hearing in the matter, before the Board of Minerals and Environment, at 9 a.m. on Thursday, May 18, 2026, or thereafter, at the . Mueller Civic Center, 401 South 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Hot Springs, South Dakota, 57747

The Intervenor further requests the subpoena require that Commissioner Greenfield bring with him when he presents himself to testify, all records retained by the Commission for School and Public Lands involving communication with surface lessee Tim Allen, Crystal Hocking, a copy of Allen’s lease agreement with the Commission, and Allen’s lease agreement with the Applicant or Basin Uranium Corp. or Cowboy Uranium on lands sought to be explored by Applicant.

This Subpoena for testimony of Commissioner Greenfield is a relevant and necessary witness in this proceedings since:

1. The issues before the Board are about whether to approve or deny issuance of a uranium exploration permit on the State's School and Public Lands;
2. Mr. Greenfield, as Commissioner for our School and Public Lands Commission has significant statutory authority and responsibility in the State's issuance of permits for mineral exploration and mining on our public lands.
3. As anticipated testimony of other witnesses and noticed documentary evidence will show at the Hearing on the above matter, Mr. Greenfield played a significant and direct role in the CNEC application process;
4. He has not been noticed as a witness by DANR or any other party to these proceedings;
5. Mr. Greenfield's testimony will therefore permit the below-signed Intervenor to present a more complete record on matters and issues under consideration by the Board in determining whether to refuse to grant and therefore deny CNEC's Application.

Based upon the likely relevance and materiality of his testimony, the Board should authorize the below-Intervenor to issue a subpoena for Commissioner Greenfield, to ensure his presence and testimony. A copy of the proposed subpoena is attached hereto.
