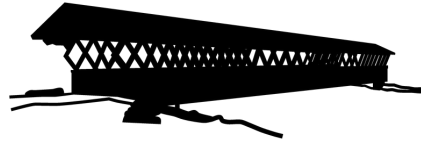

By Nexus Uranium Corp. in Fall River, South Dakota


Whereas, Nexus Uranium Corp. desires to explore for uranium by drilling 38 exploration holes in Fall River County, South Dakota; and


Whereas, Nexus Uranium Corp is committed to being a responsible neighbor, good corporate citizen, and a steward of the environment; and
