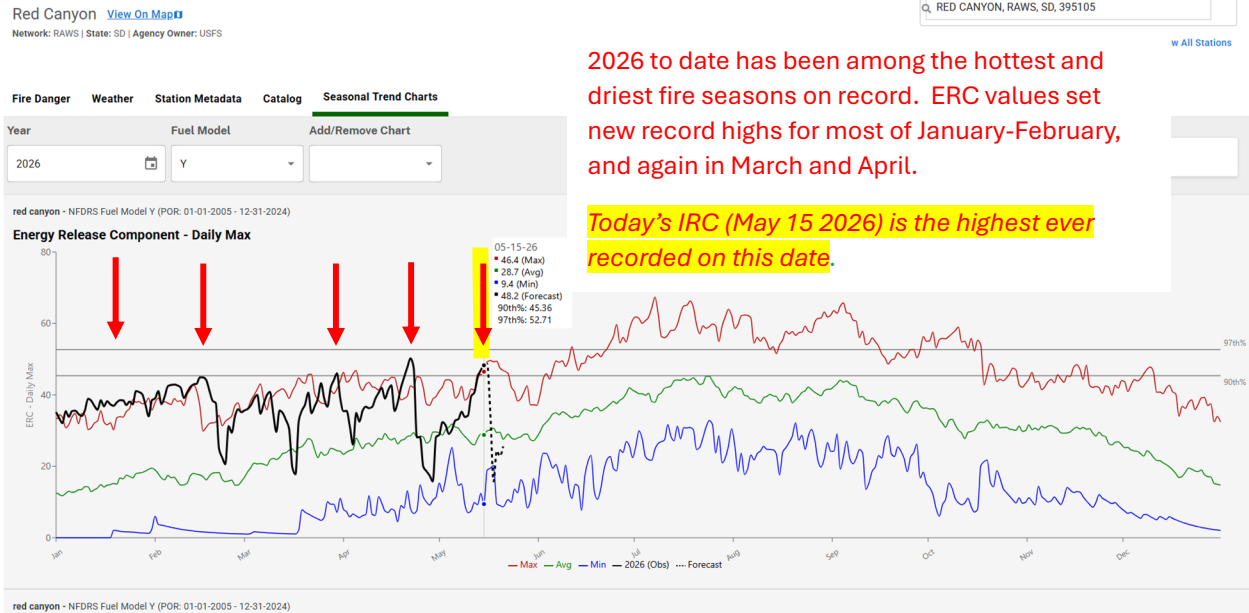

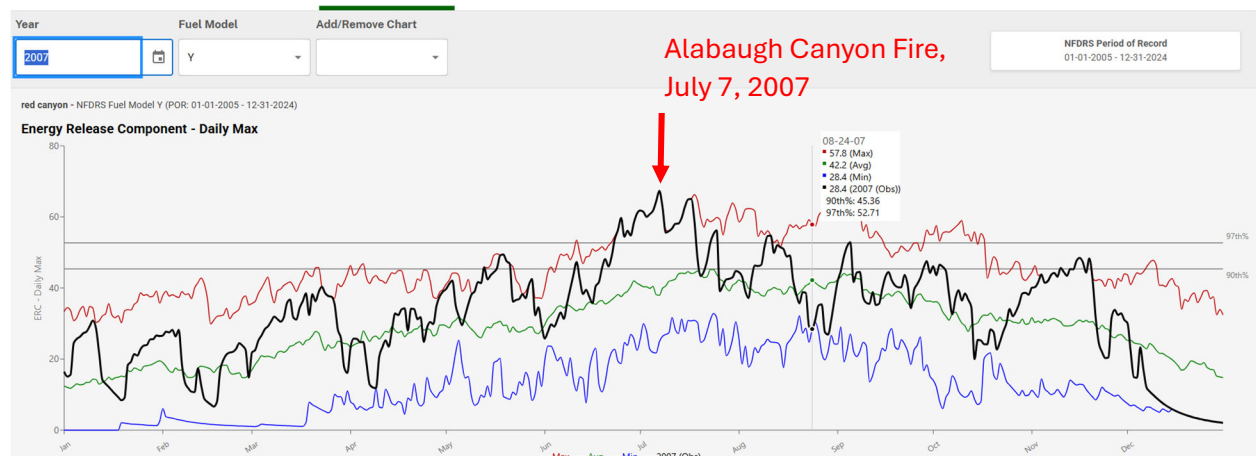
**Energy Release Component (ERC) for Red Canyon Weather Station (less than 3 miles east of Craven Canyon):**

**Alabaugh Canyon Fire**



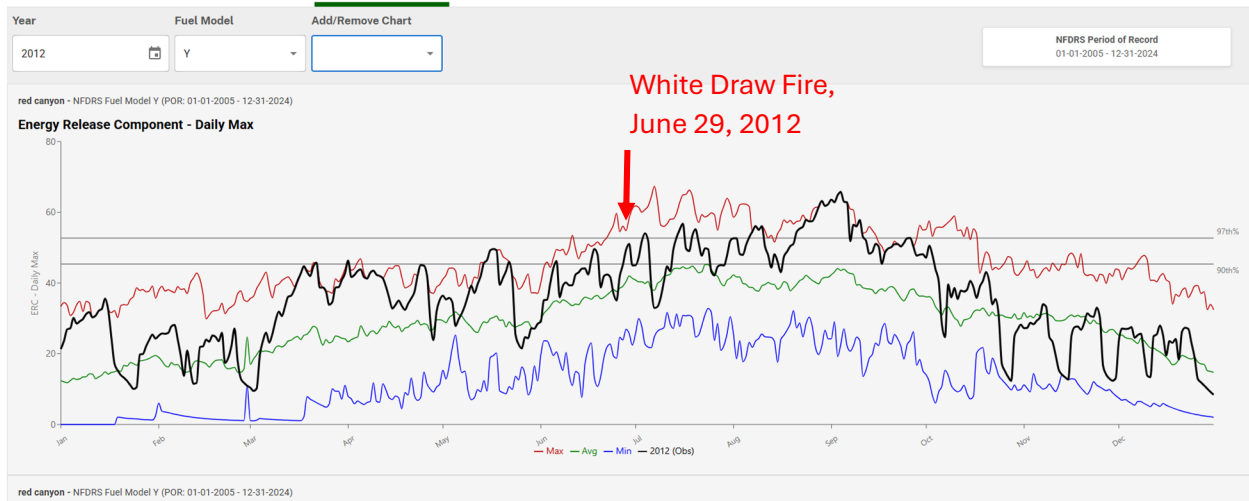
*In July 2007, the Alabaugh Fire burned 10,324 acres near Hot Springs in southern Fall River County. The fire was started by lightning on July 7th and was contained on July 12th. The fire killed one man and destroyed 33 homes. The fire forced the evacuation of about 600 residents. Fire suppression costs were estimated at \$2.7 million. A state official said the blaze was the most intense wildfire ever recorded in the Black Hills.*

## White Draw Fire



In June 2012, the White Draw Fire burned 8640 acres including parts of Craven Canyon. The fire was sparked by a vehicle in dry grass. A military C-130 air tanker crashed while fighting the fire, killing four of six of the crew on board. The costs of the destroyed aircraft and US Forest Service Equipment, plus post-removal and environmental cleanup costs, were estimated at \$43.4 million.
