

In response to your letter to Jerry Aberle dated April 25, 2022, please find below a chart outlining Dakota Gold Corp.'s ("Dakota Gold") corporate structure.



The above corporate structure is the result of Dakota Gold's (formerly JR Resources Corp.) merger with Dakota Territory Resource Corp. On March 31, 2022, Dakota Territory Resource Corp. merged with DGC Merger Sub I Corp., with Dakota Territory Resource Corp. resulting as the name of the surviving merged entity. Subsequently on March 31, 2022, Dakota Territory Resource Corp. merged with DGC Merger Sub II LLC, with DGC Merger Sub II LLC resulting as the name of the surviving merged entity. On April 5, 2022, DGC Merger Sub II LLC changed its name to DTRC LLC.

The following individuals are authorized signatories of Dakota Gold and DTRC LLC, with respect to signing paperwork associated with Exploration Notices of Intents, mine permit and other applications, and financial instruments for bonding:
