Thanks Chris. We have to know the maximum number of holes that may be drilled per pad. So shall I have it at 2 holes per pad? It is ok to request more holes than you will drill in an EXNI. For these you build your flexibility in the plan at the beginning because once approved it can't be changed.

Hi Roberta,

My apologies for the late response. Yes we propose 42 pads across 3 patented claims. At this stage we only plan to drill one hole off each pad but depending on results we may drill a few additional holes from the same pads to reduce our "footprint". We will only drill a second hole from the same position if the mineralisation is extending at depth as sufficient drill hole piece point separation is hard to achieve if the targets are only at shallow depths. Whilst diamond drilling rigs can drill far shallower inclinations, RC rigs can only adjust inclination between -90 and -50 degrees, any shallower inclination is problematic for this type of rig.
