Under the Golden Crest Plan of Operations (POO), Solitario's exploration program will consist of up to 25 drill platforms (pads) with up to 5 holes from each platform that may be a mix of angle and vertical holes of up to 1000 m depth. There may be an instance where we wish to install wedges to follow up an interesting intercept, that if this were to occur would be considered an additional drill hole.

The preferred core diameter will be HQ (63.5 mm or 2.5 inches). The drill will be a small track mounted core drill, and drilling will be conducted on previously disturbed USFS access and logging roads. Drill platforms will measure approximately 25 by 75 ft. Surface disturbance will consist of 5ft x 5ft x 5ft sumps near drill collars that will collect return water for recycling, and allow material suspended in the return water to settle out.

The Golden Crest Project will utilize a staging area, approximately 1 acre in size, and will be used to store equipment and tools.

Initially 8 to 12 holes will be drilled, but contingent on results additional permitted drill holes may be drilled.

This drill program is designed to test for lode gold and silver mineralization.

Our exploration program will use existing USFS roads; there will be no new road construction, nor will there be any modification to existing roads other than opening of berms. If berms need to be opened, the berm material will be placed

to the side of the berm and covered to mitigate against erosion, then replaced after reclamation of the drill platform has been completed.

The Golden Crest Project will use existing USFS gravel and logging roads, some of which may require special permissions and are listed in a separate Table and marked as confidential.the Table 1.

Date exploration will commence:

It is anticipated drilling will commence on or about May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024, subject to completion of the USFS Environmental Assessments, permit approvals, meteorological conditions, and access conditions as well as drill rig availability.

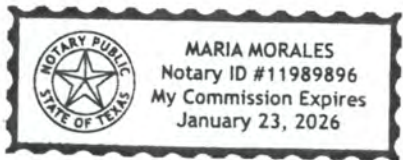

1. Describe the type of reclamation the operator proposes to achieve in the reclamation of the affected land.

The proposed drill sites are all located on USFS lands of the Black Hills National Forest that have been previously disturbed by logging and other activities. Final reclamation of the drill sites and staging area will include the following elements:

- Drill holes will be sealed and reclaimed in accordance with ARSD 74:11:08 and SDCL 45-6C-28 through 45-6C-30.
- Drill sites will be recontoured to eliminate excessive rutting regardless of the pre-project condition.
- Topsoil will be removed prior to the digging of sumps and kept for reclamation once the sump has been reclaimed. The gathered topsoil may be covered to prevent erosion while awaiting reclamation. The topsoil will be returned, graded, and reseeded.
- Secondary road areas occupied by the drill sites or staging area may be modified by installing water bars or diversion structures, as necessary and depending on the slope of the existing topography, so that post-use erosion is not promoted.
- Drill fluids will be contained in recirculation tanks or a lined sump on the drill site to allow solids to settle. The solids will ultimately be disposed of in a buried lined sump before final reclamation.
- Overly compacted areas at the drill sites, turnarounds, and staging area that are not located on an active roadbed will be roughed either manually or mechanically to enhance seeding viability and

minimize erosion. Any ruts will be leveled.

2. *Provide a proposed timetable for seeding and replanting indicating when and how the reclamation plan will be implemented. Such a timetable shall be developed in consultation with the County District Conservationist as to the nature of the soils and native vegetation in the area of the proposed operation. These recommendations shall be followed, if any are provided, and copies of all correspondence shall be provided to the Department.*

Seeding will take place after recontouring, and re-grading of disturbed areas is completed during mid to late fall or early spring. Seedings would be done on a clean, smooth, weed free seedbed with a grass seed broadcaster, then the seed will be lightly raked into the topsoil and covered with mulch.

Solitario will control all noxious weeds on areas impacted by exploration drilling throughout operations and reclamation.

All reclamation processes, seed mixes, seasonal constraints and timing and guidance will be based on Black Hills Ranger District recommendations.

Seasonal (annual) closures will be preceded by stabilization that is designed to prevent erosion at work sites.

- Areas to be enhanced by reseeding will initially be mulched with locally derived, stockpiled organic-rich amendments or with commercially available certified weed-free mulch. Seeding will be applied in accordance with USFS guidance. The proposed seed mix is provided in Table 3 and is compatible with existing habitat and USFS recommendations.

**Table 3, Reclamation Seed Mix Table: Recommended by USFS Northern Hills District, BHNH**

Application Rate: 20 Pounds Live Seed/Acre

Noxious weeds will be managed by Solitario in adherence with the USFS’s current Noxious Weed Control Plan (NWCP). Solitario will prepare a plan that will include an initial, then followed by periodic cleaning of vehicles that access drill sites. Inspections for noxious weeds and control measures as defined in the NWCP will be employed. This Plan will include spraying for weeds 1 year after final reclamation.

3. Describe how the reclamation plan will rehabilitate the affected land.

The goal of the reclamation plan is to rehabilitate and restore the affected lands to woodland grazing habitat. Planting grass would control erosion and protect the soil. Grass, forb, shrub, and subshrub communities are expected to develop as reclamation matures, which would support woodland grazing and provide an edge effect to support the wildlife in the area. It is anticipated that an aggressive noxious weed control program will benefit each drill platform as well.

Describe the anticipated temporary and permanent plugging and capping procedures to be used. Please refer to SDCL 45-6C-28 through 45-6C-30, SDCL 45-6D-33 through 45-6D-35, and the state's hole plugging regulations as detailed in ARSD 74:11.

Solitario commits to following all of the South Dakota laws and statues concerning drill hole plugging and abandonment and would install a full cement grout where needed, such as in any instance where aquifer cross contamination is possible. All of the exploration drill holes will be plugged in accordance with Administrative Rules of South Dakota (ARSD) 74:11:08 and South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) 45-6C-28 through 45- 6C-30. The drill holes are planned to penetrate the Pahasapa (Madison) and Cambrian Deadwood sedimentary formations and the older Precambrian rocks, which are water-bearing units or aquifers in some locations of the Black Hills. If an aquifer is penetrated, the completed exploration drill holes will be plugged from bottom to top using bentonite grout, which complies with the requirements of ARSD 74:11:08:05 and ARSD

74:11:08:05:01 (i.e., requirements for plugging exploration drill holes that penetrate single unconfined aquifers and confined or multiple aquifers). If a confined aquifer is penetrated, the weight of the bentonite grout column would be either sufficient to overcome formation pressure or the hole will be plugged using cement grout. The collar elevations of the planned holes are higher than the static water level to be encountered in the exploration holes; therefore, no natural artesian discharge from drill holes is anticipated.

Records regarding aquifers encountered during drilling and the plugging methods used will be recorded and retained for each exploration hole and those records would be provided to the South Dakota Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources (DANR) at the end of exploration. All exploration drill holes are planned to be plugged immediately upon completion while the drill rig is still on the site. If a drill hole temporarily needs to remain open, a temporary surface plug will be emplaced. If a hole needs to remain open for more than 30 days, Solitario will apply for an alternate plugging schedule to temporarily keep the hole open.

4. *Provide the estimated cost of implementing and completing the proposed reclamation, and, the estimated cost of plugging and sealing each test hole.*

Solitario will reclaim, recontour, reseed disturbance to any drill sites as described above as well as budget for monitoring and weed control. Currently \$2,400/platform for reclamation and monitoring is budgeted. Costs of plugging and sealing each test hole are estimated to be ~ \$25/m. Solitario will be required to post an assurance bond with the USFS. In addition, Solitario will post a statewide surety bond of \$20,000 with the State of South Dakota in lieu of drill program specific surety bonds (SDCL 45-6C-19).

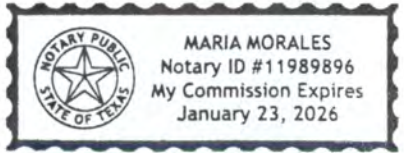



Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above referenced project pursuant to 54 U.S.C. 306108, also known as Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (as amended). The South Dakota Office of the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) concurs with your determination regarding the effect of the proposed undertaking on the non-renewable cultural resources of South Dakota.

On January 24, 2023, SHPO received your letter and the report titled "Level III Cultural Resource Inventory for the Solitario Zinc Golden Crest Project" by Lindsay D.J. Scott and Lina Ramirez of Vantage Point Solutions. The report indicates that sites 39LA0140 and 39LA0146 were monitored during the survey efforts; 39LA0140 and 39LA0146 still should be considered Eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. No other historic properties were identified during the survey efforts.

Therefore, SHPO concurs with your determination of "No Adverse Effect" for the proposed undertaking, provided the following stipulations are met: 1) The site-specific protection measures detailed on pages 50 and 53 of the report and outlined in the conclusion of the report on page 56 are followed. 2) Any gravel and/or fill necessary for road maintenance and/or berm reconstruction comes from an existing, commercial source.

Changes in the location and/or nature of activities from those identified in your request, such as any additional mining activities, will require the submission of additional documentation pertaining to the identification of historic properties, as described in 36 C.F.R. § 800.4, and/or the undertaking's effects on historic properties, as described in 36 C.F.R. § 800.11.

Concurrence of the SHPO does not relieve the federal agency official from consulting with other appropriate parties, as described in 36 C.F.R. § 800.2(c).

If historic properties are discovered or unanticipated effects on historic properties are found after the agency official has completed the Section 106 process, the agency official shall avoid, minimize or mitigate the adverse effects to such properties and notify the SHPO and Indian tribes that might attach religious and cultural significance to the affected property within 48 hours of the discovery, pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 800.13.

RESPEC sub-contracted Vantage Point Solutions to conduct a Level III cultural resource inventory for the proposed *Solitario Zinc Golden Crest Project* for the Black Hills National Forest (BKNF). The project is located entirely on lands managed by the BKNF, Northern Hills Ranger District. As the land managing agency, the BKNF is the lead agency for the project which is being accomplished under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) of 1966 (as amended). The project is located in Township 04N, Range 01E, Sections 1, 3, 10, 12, 15, 21, 22, 25-28, Township 04N, Range 02E, Sections 19, 29, 30, Township 05N, Range 01E, Sections 11, 13, 14, 24, 27, 34, 35, and Township 05N, Range 02E, Sections 7, 18, 19, and is located within Lawrence County, South Dakota on the Maurice and Savoy, SD and Old Baldy Mountain, WY 7.5' Quadrangles.

Solitario Zinc Corporation has submitted a plan of operations and are requesting approval to conduct exploratory drilling for gold southwest of Spearfish, South Dakota within claims owned by the company. The project involves exploratory drilling via 25 drilling platforms and one staging area. Existing Forest Service roads and unnamed unclassified or logging roads are to be used to access the platform locations. Some roads may require maintenance. There will be no new road construction or construction of new culverts or bridges. Equipment will access drill platforms adjacent to roads over the existing ground surface. Seven existing berms will be temporarily removed to open closed roads for equipment and vehicle access and will be reconstructed once drilling is complete. There will also be no vegetation removal other than downed vegetation that may block access. There will be no pad construction at the platforms. Drilling will be accomplished with either a wheeled, vehicle-mounted, self-leveling rig or a small, tracked drill rig. Other equipment will include a small excavator, skid-steer tractor, 4x4 vehicles, and a water truck. Drilling will be either core drilling or reverse-circulation drilling. While drilling is being performed, wastewater will be pumped into and recirculated via a sump. Sumps will be constructed approximately 2 m off the side of each drilling platform with a small excavator or skid steer tractor and will measure approximately 1.5 m square by 1.5 m deep. Each sump will be lined with a waterproof lining to keep the wastewater from infiltrating into the surrounding bedrock. Water will come from a municipal source. All sumps will be backfilled once drilling is complete and all drill holes (up to 4 per platform) will be plugged. Each platform location will be reseeded once reclamation is complete. The staging area will be used to store



equipment, drilling supplies (i.e., steel pipe), a portable toilet, trailers, waste receptacles, and other vehicles.

Because the project area is spread out over a large area, the Area of Potential Effect (APE) consists of multiple, disparate polygons, totaling 121.84 acres. The APE is designed as follows: a 60 m buffer around each drilling platform, a 30 m buffer around each berm proposed to be removed and replaced, a 2-acre area for the staging area, and a 5 m buffer each side of the centerline of access roads that are proposed to potentially require maintenance. The APE is located entirely on the BKNF (see Figure 1 in attached report). All proposed project activities must remain within the defined APE. Any project activities proposed to occur outside of the APE will require a separate Section 106 review.

The Level I inventory of the *Solitario Zinc Golden Crest Project* APE shows that 70% of the APE has prior adequate Level III cultural resources inventory that meets the SD SHPO Level III survey standards. The remaining 30%, consisting of 37.12 acres was surveyed for this project. Thus, 100% of the *Solitario Zinc Golden Crest Project* has adequate Level III inventory.

The Level I review shows that there are a total of 8 previously recorded cultural resources within the project APE (see Table 3 of attached report). Of those, two are eligible historic properties, 39LA0140 and 39LA0146. The remaining cultural resources have previously been determined as not eligible for listing to the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). No new cultural resources were located during fieldwork for this project. Both historic properties were monitored for this project and protection measures were developed so that project activities will result in no adverse effect to them. Both sites are recommended to remain eligible for listing to the NRHP. Please see the attached report *Previously Recorded Sites* section and *Conclusion* section for protection measure details.


Based on the results of the Level I and Level III inventories, the BKNF has determined a finding of **No Adverse Effect** to historic properties for the *Solitario Zinc Golden Crest Project* and that the project be allowed to proceed as planned.

However, if historic properties are discovered or unanticipated effects on historic properties are found during project activities, the agency will avoid, minimize, or mitigate the adverse effects and notify the South Dakota State Historic Preservation Office (SD SHPO) and tribal groups that have requested to be on the forest's mailing list within 48 hours of discovery, according to 36 CFR 800.13.

This report is being sent to the SD SHPO, requesting their review and concurrence on the project effects determination. It is also being sent to all Tribal Historic Preservation Officers (THPOs) that have requested to be a consulting party for the BKNF according to NHPA Section 101(d)(6)(B) for their review and comments regarding the project effects determination. Please respond to this invitation by **February 25, 2023**. In addition, the BKNF will be sending a separate invitation letter to the tribal council, inviting them to participate in government-to-government consultation on the project, if they choose to do so.

This project includes up to 25 core drilling sites for gold mineralization, access road maintenance (as needed), and reclamation activities.
