Just an FYI - I finally remembered why the drill plan seems similar. There was a limit on the drill depth for the holes originally proposed under previously approved EXNIs. So, all the pads marked in green are for drill pads that have already been approved under previous EXNIs. They are proposing increasing the allowed depth on those holes. The pads marked with the blue stars are all new and haven't been reviewed yet.
