The exploration area is generally located four miles northwest of Lead, South Dakota, within portions

Operations are anticipated to begin upon the department's issuance of written restrictions pertaining

to the Notice of Intent. The exploration project will consist of developing 33 new drill pads with up to

330 new holes drilled to a maximum vertical depth of 5,000 feet. In addition, exploration involves

increasing the maximum depth of 770 drill holes previously noticed under Exploration Notices of

Intent 444 and 446 from 3,000 feet to a vertical depth of 5,000 feet. Pads will measure approximately

100 by 100 feet. DTRC will access the site by utilizing approximately 86,100 feet of existing roads

and trails and by constructing approximately 1,900 feet of new trail.
