

**NOTICE OF FILING**  
**EXPLORATION NOTICE OF INTENT**  
**PETE LIEN & SONS, INC.**

Notice is hereby given that the South Dakota Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources has received a Notice of Intent to conduct exploration for iron and antimony deposits from Pete Lien & Sons, Inc., PO Box 440, Rapid City, South Dakota, 57709. Their resident agent is Suzanne Gabrielson, 3401 Universal Drive, Rapid City, SD 57702.

The exploration area is generally located approximately seven miles southwest of Rapid City, South Dakota, within portions of Section 30, T1N-R6E, Pennington County.

Operations are anticipated to begin upon the department's issuance of written restrictions pertaining to the Notice of Intent. The exploration project will consist of drilling up to four exploration holes to a maximum depth of 750 feet. Pads will measure approximately 30 by 50 feet. The exploration project will be accessed from existing trails and roads. The exploration will also involve approximately 2,600 feet of cross-country travel which may create an additional 0.91 acres of disturbance.
