EXPLORATION NOTICE OF INTENT  
SDO SERVICES, LLC

Notice is hereby given that the South Dakota Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources has received a Notice of Intent to conduct exploration for a lithium-bearing mineral called spodumene and associated minerals from SDO Services, LLC, 101 South Reid Street, Suite 307 - #4567, Sioux Falls, South Dakota 57103. The resident agent is Gunderson Palmer Registered Agents, LLC, 506 6th Street, Rapid City, South Dakota 57701.

The exploration area is generally located two miles northwest of Keystone, South Dakota, within portions of Section 6; T2S-R6E, Pennington County.

Operations are anticipated to begin upon the department's issuance of written restrictions pertaining to the Notice of Intent. The exploration project will consist of drilling up to 55 exploration holes to a maximum vertical depth or length of 850 feet. There will be up to 11 drill pads with a potential of up to 5 drill holes per pad, however, two drill pads may be eliminated by drilling 10 holes on two pads. Pads will measure approximately 50 by 70 feet. The exploration project area will utilize up to 24,000 feet of existing trail with estimated disturbance or improvements on up to 250 feet of those trails. Approximately 310 feet of new road may be constructed.
