#### **Application Cover Page (page 1)**

Applicant. Name, mailing address and phone number of the entity sponsoring the project.

*Proposed Funding Package*. Include the amount and type of funds requested, the amount of local funds being provided, including direct public or private contributions, loans, federal funds, and water development district grants.

*Project Title/Description.* Provide a one line title for the project and a brief narrative describing the project.

*Certification.* An official of the sponsoring entity, who has been authorized by resolution of the governing body to submit the application, must read and sign the application.

#### **Professional Contacts (page 2)**

Application Prepared By: Identify the entity, the individual that helped prepare the application, and the other contact information requested in case questions arise about the application.

Consulting Engineering Firm: Identify the engineering firm retained by the sponsor, the engineer's name, and the other contact information requested in case questions arise about the application.

#### General Information (page 2)

Provide the service area population for the drinking water system and how many service connections.

Note: Eligible water systems must have 50 or less connections, must be a not-for-profit, non-transient non-community water system, and must be in violation of the Safe Drinking Water Act.

#### Documents That Must Be Submitted With The Application (page 2)
