



Manganese in Drinking Water

A REPORT FOR WOODLAND HILLS SANITARY DISTRICT

We serve more than 255 customers an average of 19,125 gallons of water per day. Our water is groundwater that we produce from local wells. The average manganese concentration in our drinking water is 0.02 mg/l. This concentration is below health advisory levels established by the United States EPA and considered safe to drink.
