

The application requests 0.1 cfs of water to be used for commercial and domestic purposes. The source of water supply will be Durkee Lake and the diversion point will be located in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T12N, R17E in Meade County. The diversion point is in the same area where the City of Faith used to divert water (now under WR No. 948-1). The Durkee Lake dam has a height of 31 feet and a storage capacity of 1876 acre feet. The lake is located in Sections 21 and 28, T12N, R17E in Meade County. The lake receives runoff water from Spook Creek, a tributary of the Cheyenne River. The drainage area above the dam is approximately 6.4 square miles.

Review of Existing Water Rights

Game, Fish and Parks has the only existing right to the waters of Durkee Lake. The City of Faith no longer uses the Lake for their water supply. Vested Right No. 938-1 for Game, Fish and Parks allows storage of 255 acre feet annually for Durkee Lake with a 1935 priority date.

Conclusion

- 1. The O.1 cfs diversion rate will not adversely affect the existing vested right held by Game, Fish and Parks.
- 2. Unappropriated water is available in Durkee Lake.
- 3. Approval of this permit is in the public interest.

These hearings are adversary proceedings. Any party has the right to be present or to be represented by a lawyer. These and other due process rights will be forfeited if they are not exercised. Decisions of the Board may be appealed to the Circuit Court and State Supreme Court as provided by law.

The time of the hearing will be automatically extended for at least twenty days upon your written request to the Chief Engineer after a petition has been filed to oppose the cancellation. If an extension is requested, the hearing on the cancellation will be continued until the next regular Board Meeting. Any request for extension must be filed with the Chief Engineer by April 20, 2001.
