

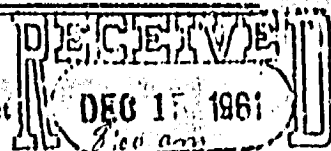

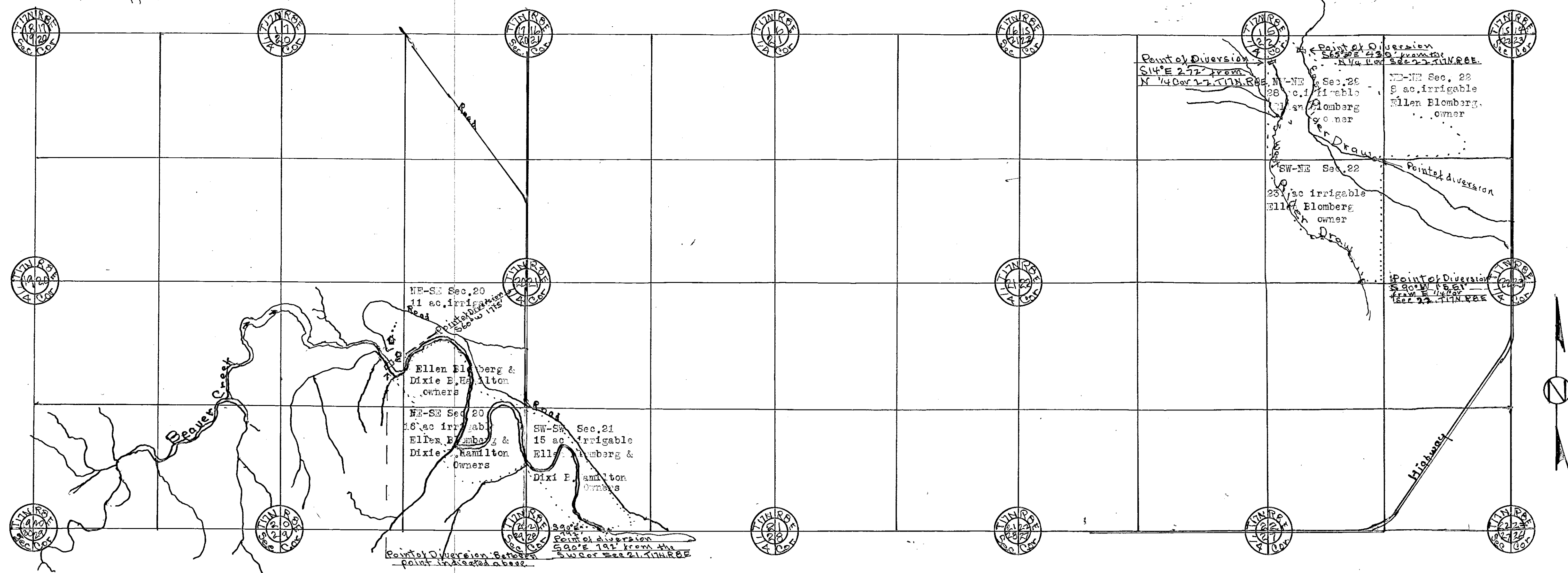
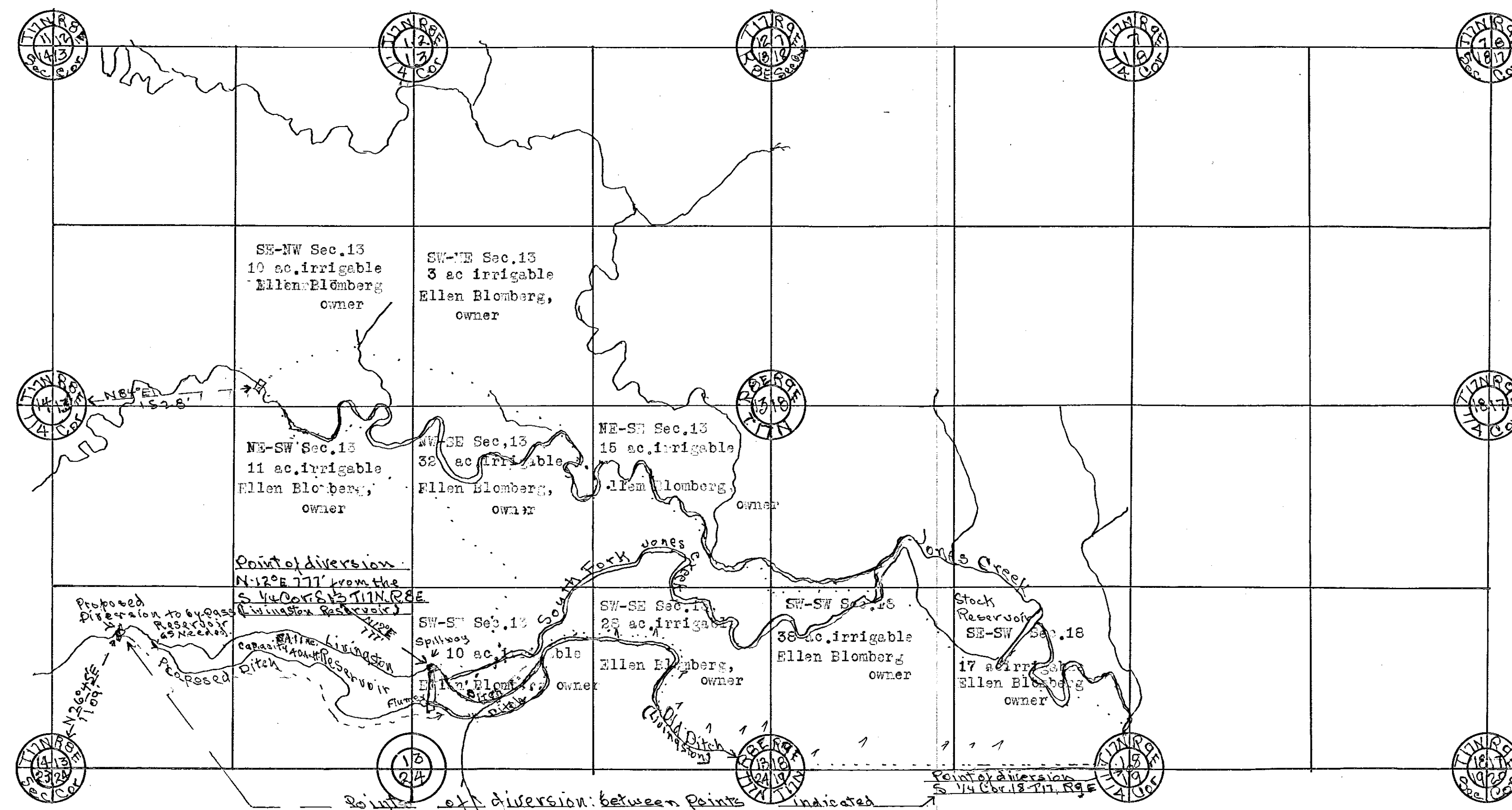

Our records indicate that the 1984 Irrigation Questionnaire has not been submitted for Permit No(s) 625-1. The request for the Questionnaire was dated October 17, 1984. The Water Management Board has directed that notice of water permits who have not submitted 1984 Irrigation Questionnaires be given notice of hearing(s) to be held by the Board to determine if any action is to be taken concerning the violation.

The hearings will be held at 10:30 a.m., May 15, 1985 in the Civil Defense Room, State Capitol Building, Pierre, South Dakota.

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to the provisions of SDCL 46-1-12, 46-1-14, 46-2-9, 46-2-11, and 46-2-17. These are contested case hearings pursuant to procedures contained in SDCL 1-26. Following the hearing(s), the Water Management Board can:

1. Amend Permit No(s) 625-1 to require the Irrigation Water Use Questionnaire to be submitted each year;
2. Postpone any action;
3. Take no action.

The hearing(s) is an adversary proceeding. The permit owner has the right to be present or to be represented by a lawyer. These and other due process rights may be forfeited if they are not exercised. Decisions of the Board may be appealed to the Circuit Court and the State Supreme Court as provided by law.
