



RECOMMENDATIONS FOR OELRICHS:

1. A test kit should be provided so that the residual chlorine in the distribution system can be determined. Measurement of the chlorine residual should be performed by the operator at least once per week.
2. To protect the city of Oelrichs water supply source, water rights should be obtained. Applications may be obtained from the South Dakota Department of Water and Natural Resources, Pierre, South Dakota.
3. It is recommended that water works records of water consumption, power usage, chlorine residual, and maintenance activities should be collected to effectively plan future water works improvements and forewarn of impending malfunctions before they become major problems.
4. Current design criteria do not recommend the use of pits due to the possibility of flooding.
5. All overflow and vent pipes should be screened.

The United States Fire Insurance Services do not recommend the use of water mains smaller than 6 inches in diameter. A pumper fire truck should never be connected to a fire hydrant serving mains less than 6 inches in diameter because contamination of water supply could result in back siphonage conditions or damage to the distribution system because of possible negative pressures. To be assured of adequate fire and back siphonage protection all future water main installations must be 6 inches in diameter or larger. The Department of Water and Natural Resources recommends that when using less than 6 inch diameter mains, only flushing hydrants be installed.

BACTERIOLOGICAL SAMPLING & ANALYSIS:

The State Department of Water & Natural Resources requires that all public water supplies submit water samples on a routine basis to the State Department of Health Laboratory in Pierre. Bacteriological samples should be collected from different points in the distribution system so that the water sampling record will provide an indication of the water quality within the entire distribution system.

Dear Sir:

Enclosed is Water License No. 1690-2. This is the final water right document completing your process of obtaining a Water Right.

For your information SDCL 46-6-27 requires that if the owner of an existing well, such as the well authorized by Water Right No. 1690-2, constructs a replacement well and does not plan to use the old well, the old well is considered abandoned and must be plugged. Also, any well that is being used or is not considered abandoned must be valved and controlled, if flowing, or sealed and capped so that no leaking occurs either underground or at the surface.




