

I am contacting you in regard to Water Right No. 889-2 held by the city of Presho. Enclosed is a copy of the water right. A review of the file found the water license was issued incorrectly as far as the legal description of the wells.

We would like to go ahead and reissue the water license to correct the error but prior to doing that wanted to check with the city to see which wells were still being used.

Our Drinking Water Program within the Department indicated the city is supplied water from the West River-Lyman Jones Rural Water System. Their records show that only one of the three wells was still in service and was being maintained as a backup water supply.

Please review the enclosed material and mark on the map or "Examination of Works" form which well is being maintained. Also, please make a notation as to the pump rate that the well could divert at if needed.

As soon as we receive the information back from you, we can go ahead and update the water right with the changes and reissue the water license to reflect the city's use. Thank you for sending in the information concerning the city's water use and the location of the wells they maintain. Enclosed is Reissued Water License No. 889-2. The water license was reissued to correct errors in the legal description of the wells.

For your information SDCL 46-6-27 requires that if the owner of an existing well(s), such as the wells authorized by Water Right No. 889-2, constructs a replacement well and does not plan to use the old well, the old well is considered abandoned and must be plugged. Also, any well that is being used or is not considered abandoned must be valved and controlled, if flowing, or sealed and capped so that no leaking occurs either underground or at the surface.

As long as you use the water beneficially, as stated in the Water License, the State Water Laws provide that you have a continuing right to use the water. If you have any questions, please contact our office.

## STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA

### REISSUED WATER LICENSE NO. 889-2

(1) The City of Presho, PO Box 354, Presho SD 57568 was issued Water License No. 889-2, February 8, 1973 for a water right to divert 1.00 cubic feet of water per second from ground water (three wells – Dakota formation), Lyman County, South Dakota for municipal purposes. Water License No. 889-2, with priority dates of 1940, 1948 and 1966 was issued to the permit holder for diversion of water with construction of the water supply system and the application to beneficial use of water completed.

A review of the original water license found the well locations to be incorrectly described. The city was contacted and confirmed which wells are still used. They are currently hooked to the West-River Lyman Jones Rural Water System and have two wells they maintain. The water license is being reissued to correct the legal descriptions of the wells. The remaining portions of the original license have not been altered.

(2) The water supply system has been completed and water applied to beneficial use in accordance with South Dakota State Law. Pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law 46-5-30.1, the City of Presho the holder and/or owner of Water Right No. 889-2 is issued a license, bearing priority dates of 1940 (0.14 cfs), 1948 (0.23 cfs) and June 9, 1966 (0.63 cfs) to appropriate 1.00 cubic feet of water per second from ground water (two wells) for municipal purposes.

The diversion points are located as follows:

- Main well (1775 feet deep) – NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, T105N, R77W and
- Uptown well (1492 feet deep) – NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, T105N, R77W.
